They all came back to get warmed up both inside and out and were smiling throughout. Our long-suffering landowners continue to support the club by providing sites for us to practice our driving skills, thanks also go to them. We returned to Delamont for our first autotest of the year which attracted a brilliant entry of 28 competitors. The day was cold and brisk but thankfully dry. David Thompson from Manorhamilton joined us for the first time in ages and won the event by a good margin. Ashley Lamont and Mark King were also there to demonstrate their skills. In fact both Mark and David started their autotesting careers with The Ulster Centre so our tutorials seem to work. We held a marshals' tutorial before the autotest familiarising everybody with how faults are assessed and with the timing equipment we would use on the championship autotest in April.

Nutts Corner was the next venue for the March autotest and we started the day with a drivers' tutorial for ten enthusiastic competitors. This was followed by the autotest at which there were 35 taking part, another great entry. Tea and coffee were available, as always, and very welcome throughout the day. Andrew Blair won the event with Richard Earney following closely behind.

Our next competitive event was held on 2 April at Balmoral Park, The Maze, Lisburn where we hosted the 3<sup>rd</sup> Round of the NI Autotest Championship with 20 young men champing at the bit to get started in their various cars, 5 of whom were Ulster Centre members. Colin Earney was Clerk of the Course and together with his team kept things running smoothly all day. There wasn't a gripe from anybody which is rare at any event. The quality of driving was "out of this world", utterly amazing and a joy to behold. The advancement of the discipline over the past 20 years is unbelievable. Ashley Lamont won overall with Paul Mooney a close second and Paul Blair won his class. The awards were very generously sponsored by CIP Insurance courtesy of Conn and Paul Williamson.
